

## Whitewater is a Bird City!

The City of Whitewater is a designated Wisconsin Bird City because the Urban Forestry Commission supports bird education and habitat at the following locations:

Martin Mansions - There are three successful Purple Martin houses at Minneiska Park, Clay Street Nature Park, and the Arboretum At Starin Park. Each Martin house has a landlord who monitors and reports to the National Purple Martin Association.

Bluebird Lane - The Bluebird trail is located on the south end of Minneiska Park. It is monitored to keep non-native invasive house sparrows out.

Swallow Street - The Tree Swallow trail is located west of Tripp Lake, also at Minneiska Park, at the end of Bluebird Lane and leads to the Purple Martin house there. It is also monitored to keep non-native invasive house sparrows out.
